The Argyle Family and Haiti Earthquake Relief

The church needs to know that the Argyle family has partnered with **Global Samaritan** (Abilene, Texas) and **Healing Hands International** (Nashville, Tennessee) to funnel relief resources to Haiti, and those locations most affected by the earthquake and aftershocks. In March, we sent funds to assist in developing water resources to guard the health of Haitians, and we are also helping to assist with immediate medical needs.

It is a challenge to know how to help and do it without doing more damage. Inadvertently, our government was supplying less expensive rice from Arkansas to needy Haitians, not realizing that doing so was undermining struggling Haitian farmers who could not beat the price of the imported rice. (Argyle’s rice donations were not for sale on the market, so rest easy.)

With our partnering with Global Samaritan/Healing Hands, we are taking advantage of people who handle resources and come upon equipment deals that improve lives for the public without competing against the local business interests in Haiti. Improved health and an environment for growing opportunities result. God grant us the wisdom and heart to help. -Ken
