Genesis 22:1-19

Recall our focus: What is God doing?
What does God want?

1. Blatant truth: God tests Abraham.

Will trust move us to obey even if we don't understand?
2. We surrendered our past –

will we surrender our future?
3. Abraham as teacher: ambiguous hope –

we will come back to you.
4. For what is not apparent to me –

God has an answer.
5. Two lessons forever:
 - a. God will provide.

(he will make it evident).
 - b. Abraham: "I put God first."

It is also a good time to donate pencils and crayons for VBS for next summer's mission trips. Those can be given to Marian McClaren.

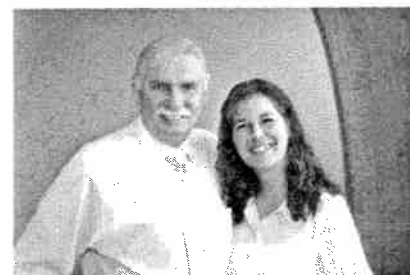
Raised in Him
