## Relationships Matter

The Argyle church family is partnering with our fellow disciples at the San Jose Church of Christ (and others) to bring Jerry and Lynn Jones to offer several helpful presentations to the Jacksonville area community. These are relationship oriented sessions - about marriage, about friends and acquaintances, about families and parenting.

This afternoon there are messages about "Recovery." Specifically, the circumstances of death and divorce will be considered at the 2 PM session. Obviously, the issues and situations created by death and divorce will not be treated exhaustively, but certainly, they will be framed in helpful ways; the possibilities of resolution and the paths to restoring healthy relationship patterns will be explored.

Is Parenting a serious concern and challenge? Come out at 3 PM this afternoon to stake out the territory and discover hope from resource people who have been able to assist significant numbers of single parents and couples. This is one area where people are desperate for positive input to help them honor God in guiding their children to maturity.

Some of the encouragement in these messages will be basic to many of life's relationships - there is troubleshooting and preventative maintenance about communication, listening skills, and expectations we bring to our interactions with others. And some of these presentations are crisis oriented, dealing with situations like pornography and changes in life's circumstances.

This event at the San Jose church presents an opportunity to gauge the health of our own personal relationships, and it also provides a platform to formulate strategy for serving others. Grab a brochure and find a topic of interest, then snag a friend or partner and find a blessing in exploring renewed health and healing in relationships.

Relationship Matters continues through Wednesday night at the San Jose church building. No charge to attendees, and child care is available.

because worship is about what God is up to.

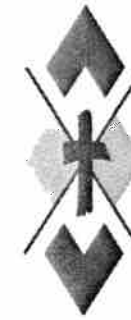
