There has been an Argyle Church of Christ since 1991. It has never been this church without “Kitty” Mitchell, who along with husband (Allen) Lee, pledged their home as collateral with nine other families to secure the funds that seeded this church plant nineteen years ago.



That faith has enabled the blessing that God intends and that many of us have found in this church family. It is, in one sense, “home, sweet home.” And then from God’s superior vantage, it is “home away from home.” It has been that for Kitty, but her moving day was February 16; she has an even better home now.

Kitty’s faith and life have been about the possibilities which the Lord would open up; she grew up in a depression era family, fraught with economic obstacles and frustrations, yet, would go to two Christian colleges, graduating with credentials in art and education. “Miss Lowe”/ “Mrs. Mitchell” would invest herself in students for 34 years in Duval County public schools – what would become of the hearts and minds she helped to mold and prepare? Only God knows!

She would invest herself in a 58 year marriage with Lee, and God would allow them to see decades of service and fruit in his kingdom. God would use them to teach and to model and to serve, to accomplish his will, to guide and to encourage. Sometimes it seems the work will never be finished. But it will. And for now, “blessed are the dead who from now on die in the Lord. Yes,” says the Spirit, “they will rest from their labors, for their deeds follow them.” It is a sweet parade! - Ken

8. Jesus prayed that we would be one with God.

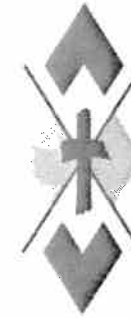
