It is a confession of interdependence: "we are members of one another" (Romans 12:5). It is owning a shared commitment: "the members have the same care for one another" (I Corinthians 12:25).

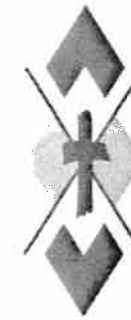
