## “Biblical Destruction”

With the earthquake devastation in Haiti, I knew someone would describe it in time as “Biblical” in “proportions.” Sure enough! The Drudge Report came through. Now, will we also magnify the grace of God and call the relief effort one of “Biblical proportions”?

Jesus puts the brakes on us, preventing the leap to judgment about tragedies and disasters. He suggests they are not moments of judgment as much as wake-up calls to repentance. “No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all perish just as they did” (Luke 13:1-5).

Then, at last, maybe we see the moment as a vista of opportunity open for us to offer the compassion and kindness God has shared with us, and we become the hands and feet, even the heart and mind, of Jesus.

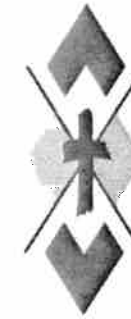
