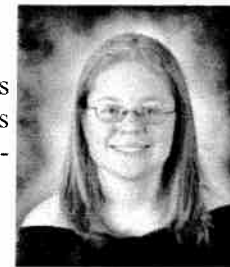
Tuesday night, July 6 at 6:45 PM and Friday night, July 9 at 8:55 PM. Both games are at the Ringhaver #4 field.
