“We” are not done yet.

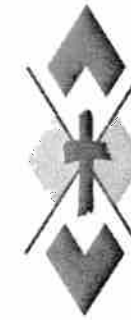

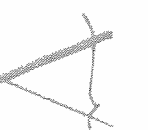
