I think it was when I was about 14 that I noticed language and faith could take some effort – about the time the preacher was reading, “we do you to wit the grace of God.” I thought to myself, “What did he say?” Listening more closely didn’t help: “touching the ministering to the saints, it is superfluous for me to write to you: for I know the forwardness of your mind for which I boost of you to them of Macedonia, that Achaia was ready a year ago; and your zeal hath provoked very many.” Was that a good thing or a bad thing? I wasn’t sure.

I love my faith. It keeps me sharp and in tune and in touch with where I came from. I am at times clueless about details, but being curious, I listen to Casey Stengel and James Thurber as they famously say, “you could look it up.”

And today, we waft. I will explain.

This month I promised some folks we would do some “older,” Stamps-Baxter type songs from our heritage, and today’s is “When All of God’s Singers Get Home.” In 1937 this would have been a contemporary praise song, vexing people who like classic hymns! In that work, we “waft” a song of delight. I had to look it up.

Wafting is to carry lightly through the air or over the water... to let something float, to blow gently.

We will waft songs. In fact, let us waft our prayers, today and through the week for our Nicaragua team and the youth out in Louisiana, and for our church here, and for folks who are searching for God, for gratitude with the kindness of God lavished on us in Christ.

5. Quest: Can God do anything more than destroy?

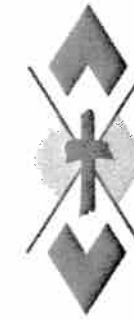
