Happy Father's Day! "*Honor your father and mother,*" Paul writes in Ephesians 6, an echo of the first of the Ten Commandments that deal with human relationships. This is "*the first commandment with a promise*" which Paul has updated the interpretation of—*that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on earth.*"

Honor is usually a prerogative we reserve for God, but David shares with us in Psalm 8 that the LORD (Yahweh), whose name is majestic in all the earth, made man "*a little lower than God, and crowned him with glory and honor.*" We recognize in each other such divine investment that acknowledging the dignity of a person is a way to recognize our creator for the greatness the Father has and the majesty the Father is.

I hope you have good memories of "dad," or if he is physically alive still, that your relationship with him is healthy and cherished. The reality of our walk in this world is that often the personal alienation we are prone to spills over even into the intimate relationships we have in our flesh and blood families. If you feel you are a spiritual orphan today, know that God has volunteered to be "*A father to the fatherless*" (Psalm 68:5). Call on him as "Abba, Father," as Jesus teaches us and the Spirit enables us!

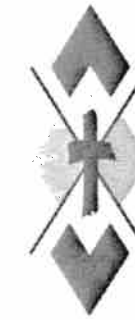
