## Finding God in Life's Rhythm

If you are following the readings this month, then you have been immersed in Psalm 3 last week and this week, we will spend time in Psalms 5 and 4. They are reversed for a reason.

Psalm 3 contains, about midway through, the lines

I lie down and sleep;  
I wake again, for the LORD sustains me.

This week Psalm 4, as we retire in the evening, reminds us

When you are disturbed, do not sin;  
Ponder it on your beds, and be silent.

And

I will both lie down and sleep in peace;  
For you alone, O LORD, make me lie down  
in safety.

Waking up with Psalm 5 in the morning, we pray

O LORD, in the morning you hear my voice;  
In the morning I plead my case to you,  
and watch.

I do not know who arranged the Psalms in the Psalter, but all three of these are attributed to David, and I think the practice of his last waking thoughts being of the Lord, and his first greetings in the morning being to the Lord worked well for him. Try it this week. Let's set ourselves up with the thought, it is the day the Lord is making, and he is present in it, and I am here for him.

we belong to each other.

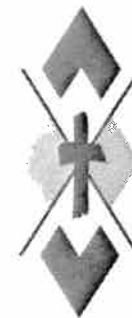
