3. Covenant: we belong to Christ.
 - a sacrifice for redemption.

 - Result: we belong to each other.

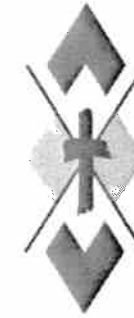
