## Attention Parents!

Here's some information about the worship/Bible class time-switch **next Sunday, March 6** and how it will affect your child.

### During worship:

Children aged 4 years through 5th grade should be taken into worship assembly. 4 year olds through 2nd graders will be released before the sermon for Wee Worship. After worship assembly, a teacher (or adult helper) will pick up your child from Wee Worship and take them to their appropriate classes.

3rd-5th graders will be released from worship at the end of the service and should go straight to their Bible class.

### After Bible study:

4 year olds-Kindergarteners should be picked up from their class directly after class is over.

1st-5th grade students will be directed to meet up with their parents in the Fellowship Hall or the foyer just outside the Fellowship Hall. Please do not allow your older child(ren) to pick up your younger child(ren) from Bible class.
