A Perspective on 20 Years

Paul in Romans has a sense that his ministry is in transition, and he has his eyes set on new horizons ó Spain. It might have been a natural time to take satisfaction in past accomplishment, but he doesn't yield to this. Rather, he states boldly, ***"I glory in Christ Jesus in my service to God. I will not venture to speak of anything except what Christ has accomplished through me..."*** (Romans 15:17-18). With Paul, so with us, that we have been an opportunity for Christ Jesus to ***"display his unlimited patience as an example for those who believe on him and receive eternal life"*** (I Timothy 1:16). It is an adventuresome and satisfying ride that God is sharing with us. As a church, we confess the 20 years not as the skill and finesse of ourselves, but as what Christ has accomplished through us! And it whets our appetite for more, and with greater intensity.

Now to the King Eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen (I Timothy 1:17).
