Give Peace a Chance

Matthew 5:9

The type of peace Jesus is talking about can be understood in two ways:

1. It has more to do with the reign of God than the reign of Rome.

Today when we talk about peace we are usually talking about peace that gets us what we want.
2. It has more to do with righteousness than the absence of conflict.

Jesus is aiming for authentic reconciliation.

Giving Peace a Chance Involves...

1. Leaving one's comfort zone and dealing with conflict at some point in the journey.
2. Bearing more scars that we inflict.
3. You knowing the peace giver before you can become a peacemaker.
