Remind them of God's loving care.

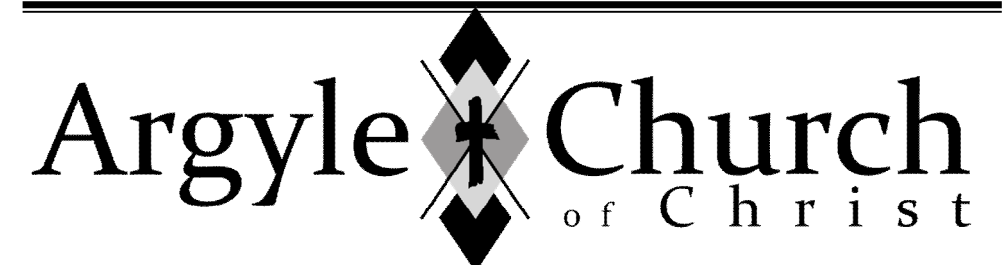
